But, as we are told in the Great Commission, more discipling takes place. We continue to learn, we are continuing to be transformed, as God's Spirit reshapes us into the life of Jesus. Paul reminds us again, "If you have been raised with him, seek the things that are above where he is, seated at the right hand of God." Colossians 3:1-2 So today, Steve joins the rest of us in that part of the journey. Encourage his faith.
