When Paul wrote in Galatians 3, *"28 There is no Jew or Greek, slave or free, male or female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus",* he wasn't denying heritage, social state or biology. He wasn't saying that such places don't exist and you can freely move from one to the other, just wherever you want to be. He was saying that for any and every individual, whatever their lot, all of us have our identity in Christ. In that place, we are the same.

There is no room for someone to announce to the world, "I'm different than what I am, and you have to accept that or the evil is in you." You see, it is being portrayed in the media, that if you don't accept Jenner's status, however he defines it, then you are a bigot, or intolerant, or somehow deficient. Much of culture says, "Accept everyone, however they see themselves or you are evil."

Then Rachel Dolezal shows up... *How dare she! She isn't black! She can't do that!* You aren't hearing a lot of tolerance in her situation. You see, if scientists searched her DNA, ran her chemistry through the Human Genome Project, there would be an answer as to the sequence of her genetic pattern from both a physical and functional pattern.

I do feel for, and grieve with children who are spun up on the "augers" of parents who want to define themselves on their own terms. I also grieve for the society who cannot see the flaw in the reasoning process.
