Himself through us... we also have a responsibility to only use Scripture in the way that God intended. To attempt to address every scientific technology by looking at "what the Bible says about it" is impractical. The Bible does not address the medical use of psychotropic medications. The Bible does not inform us about the origins of depression, the treatment of medical conditions or a host of other things. They were not 1st century questions.

The Bible informs and benefits us for teaching, for rebuking, for correction, for training us in right living, so that we may be mature and equipped for every good work. (2 Timothy 3:16)

But from that verse people go on to attempt to prove that the Bible informs us as to which political party to belong to, which cultural norm we can participate in or must abstain from. From such positions we have made decrees about bathing suits, the sinfulness of a woman exposing her ankles in public, the necessity of wearing hats by women in the assemblies, the morality of owning other human beings, sinfulness of clapping hands at certain events, watching football games on Sundays, cutting wheat on the "Sabbath" and hundreds of other rules and regulations that the Bible never envisioned.

This isn't letting the Bible speak to a topic, it is humankind taking the authority from God and implementing their own agenda. Now, I know we didn't do it consciously, we began with a false assumption. The assumption was that the Bible defines every action that a Christian can participate in. That just isn't true. The Bible doesn't talk about your bowling or not bowling. The Bible does say that you must be righteous in your behavior and to be prepared to engage in every good work.

We must be very careful about not making the Bible say more than God intended. When we do that, we become the standard rather than God.
