that doesn't fill all the requirements. The truth that is presented has to fill a need for those who are listening. The need may be understood by them, or defined in Scripture and unknown to them, but it must be timely.

I could preach a lesson from Genesis 1 about God's creation story every Sunday for the rest of my life and it could be true, but would it fill a need? Filling 25-40 minutes of "air time" with accurate information that applies to no one is a waste of everyone's time.

The art or task of preaching is to attempt to present the message of God as revealed in Scripture accurately, pointedly, and in its entirety. The Bible talks about the "whole counsel of God", and knowing that we are preparing and presenting not only what God forbids us from doing, but also the dream of who God calls us to be is an enormous task. It isn't about cutesy stories or the latest internet sensation.

Where belonging to God means belonging to each other.

Churches who attempt to mature their members with no more thought than the latest Facebook feed are resulting in sickly, malnourished and stunted disciples. It isn't because of a lack of truthful information, it is because the information is not pointed toward specific needs and anticipating future development.

So, in your praying in the next few weeks, remember me as I work through my sermons for 2016. I want the material to be accurate, but it must also be helpful to you.
