The message of God, especially when presented as I have here, over a long period of time, is to bring nourishment, refreshing, and growth. It need not be violent, nor thunderous, but must always lead to God. As Moses concludes, "May God's name be proclaimed and his greatness presented." In the end, this is the purpose of teaching, the intent of every servant of God. While styles vary, and the times call for different emphasis, George Shelton, Thayer Salisbury, David Lewis, Tom Turner and I, who have been the ministers at different times in the past 45 years, on our best days did exactly this and nothing else. We attempt to lift up God and his message to each generation.

It isn't moving through like a prairie fire, consuming all that is before it. It isn't a tornado of epic portions. It is like a gentle rain, bringing strength for what lies ahead. As always, may God be praised.
