It is important to remember, the natural response to the recognition of such love is to love in return. It is during this reciprocal love, moving back and forth between us and God, that the most meaningful portion of our relationship exists. Our devotions, worship, praise become sweeter, more intense and spiritually significant.

We become, as Scripture describes, "like a deer panting for water, our souls longing for Him." We have the confidence of the Psalmist of Psalm 125, knowing "as the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord surrounds his people." Knowing our sin is removed from us, "as far as the east is from the west", we are confident in His presence, exuding joy, pleasure and intimacy. We trust, not ourselves fickle as we may be, but the steadfast love of God, ever present, unending in nature and overflowing to his people.

I pray the above paragraph describes your state this day. I pray your experience as you commune with God today is one that draws you deeper into the relationship that supersedes any other that you will ever experience.

I spent time with a group of ministers this week as we studied what is referred to as the Five Megillot, the books of Ruth, Song of Songs, Lamentations, Ecclesiastes, and Esther. All books that are short books of Scripture, lumped together in the Jewish Bible.
