thick headed. Why didn't she and the others know Jesus would reappear? He had promised, taught about it, and foretold the story. Was it a lack of faith?

I don't think so. I think they experienced what psychologists call "cognitive dissonance". It means that all of the information they were receiving just overloaded their thinking. It was "too much".

We have the advantage, having grown up with the story. As long as there have been Easter Sundays, the story has been repeated and many days unassociated with Easter. We've become used to the idea of a resurrection.

Isn't that extraordinary? That we have learned to see as "normal" or a matter of record that one can return from the dead. If you step back and think about it, you may share some of their cognitive dissonance. Rise from the dead?

We've been to thousands of funerals and it has never happened. We are surrounded by cemeteries full of dead men's bones.

But today, amid the Easter bunnies, colored eggs, and chocolate bunnies, people are thinking of an empty tomb. We take it as a given.

What an incredible God we serve.
