their homes and taken to a foreign country away from friends and family. Endless stories.

During these individual crisis points, God weaves a story of their developing faith and his care. Each of these people were depending on the stories that they had heard beforehand about God's acting in the lives of Joseph, or Abraham or David.

Hearing the earlier stories laid the foundation for them to act in faith in their own immediate crisis. That is why we repeat the stories today in VBS or as children lie down to sleep—for some coming crisis yet to be seen. During this Saturday and Sunday, we lay a foundation upon which we trust that God will build a faithful life.

Crisis will come. Families will undergo changes... some will die, others will leave, and new members will enter. Stories of faith help us understand how faithful people of God in the past have dealt with it. Moves will happen, across counties, states, and into other countries, but we can read of others whose faith withstood the same.

Faith-filled stories, retold to build faith-filled lives.


