I've tried to show you what I understand God to be like through my teaching and my behavior. Both Janet and I have attempted to model grace and mercy to any we come in contact with. I've wanted to be sacrificial in my interaction with others. I say none of this to try to exalt myself, but to convey my purpose, my goals.

My limited mind can only comprehend a small understanding of the majestic character of God. I believe what I've taught to be in keeping with what I've learned. I do believe and have prayed that God will raise up someone else who could, with the same commitment, share his vision of God, from his perspective.

For two years I've spent countless hours praying for the discernment of our shepherds in the selection of that man. They have selected John McKeel, I trust God has raised him up.
