Sometime in the late 1940s, Celevonio "C.S." Zuniga was baptized here in St. John. Brother Love was preaching, and Brother Broadfoot was an elder. Since no one could pronounce "Celevonio," people just called him "Slim." Brother Zuniga liked his nickname, and later on, when he began preaching, he shortened his name to "C.S." which was easier for everyone to pronounce.

After his conversion, C.S. began preaching among Spanish-speaking people throughout the southwest and in Mexico. At the close of his life, he was recognized by Abilene Christian University for his work among Spanish-speaking people. C.S. also helped Juan Monroy, the famous Spanish preacher, with his far-reaching ministry. Celevonio's son, Miles, just retired from preaching in San Angelo where he follows in his father's footsteps and continues to teach. The entire Zuniga family is grateful to the love shown them and still consider St. John home.

Over the years, we have continued to reach out to Mexico in our missions. We currently support three works there: Jorge (Coco) and Latisha Serrano in Oaxaca, Ubaldo and Maria Cardona in Chihuahua, and Rick Owens as he builds facilities for churches and schools there.
