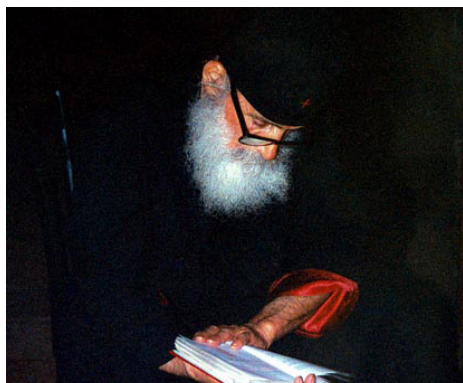
Prayer Requests

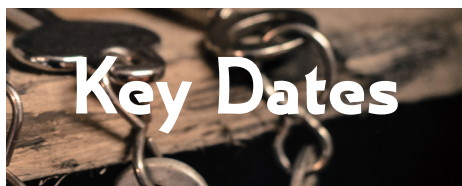

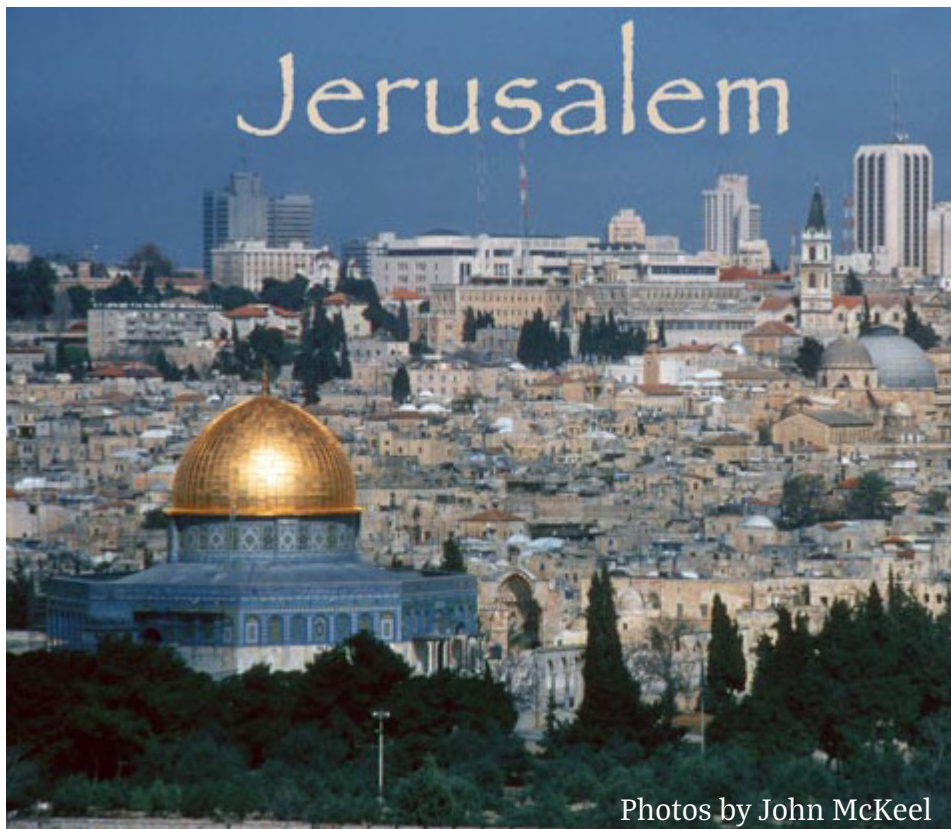
