years, and lived seven.” Are you living your life or just existing?

The Apostle Peter begins his first letter:

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead

(1 Peter 1:3).

Have you ever considered what the words “living hope” mean? It’s hope that gives life!

Christians are often accused of not knowing how to live. We are painted in boring shades of grey, when the fact is: our faith gives us hope, and hope gives us:

- Joy, Romans 5:2
- Comfort in sorrow, 1 Thessalonians 4:18
- Confident assurance, Hebrews 6:18, 19
- Motivation for holy living, 1 John 3:3

We are “saved in hope” (Romans 8:24), and our hope is based on the written Word of God, Psalms 119:49.

“May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope” (Romans 15:13).
