We've taken 3 weeks to describe our efforts to cover Genesis. Today we introduce the final character from Genesis, from Abraham's line, Joseph. Joseph is the great-grandson of Abraham, the grandson of Isaac, the 11th and favorite son of Jacob (Israel) by his favorite wife, Rachel. By sheer volume, Joseph is the pivotal character, as his story begins in the 30th chapter and concludes in the 50th chapter. In the story of Joseph we see God using him by giving him dreams, which resulted in jealousy and strife with his brothers. His favored status with his father results in betrayal and bondage. We could focus on the theme of betrayal and bondage, but we choose to focus on God.

Joseph is transported to Egypt, sold into slavery, and experiences challenge after challenge in life. He has success as a slave, is betrayed by Potipher's wife, imprisoned, appears doomed. He experiences dreams with the cupbearer and baker, is forgotten, then remembered. His hopes rise and fall. He, as a God follower (<u>People</u>), repeatedly trusts God while being provided with dreams, success, and opportunities (<u>Provision</u>), after each set back. God (<u>Person</u>) proves faithful, working out a plan that ultimately saves all of Joseph's family, resulting in their move to Egypt.

The story is incredible. Movies, Broadway shows, books, and poetry have told and retold the tale. Seeing what God has done has been repeatedly related in secular entertainment, the powerful event has offered hope and comfort to people across time. Remember, God has saved this information for us, you and I, more of his people, so that we might have faith in what he will do, confidence that we are not forsaken, and the willingness to look in anticipation of his action in our own lives.
