In Genesis, God (Person) shows his faithful, loving nature in making a promise to Abraham (People), to bless (Provision) him and all nations of the world through him, if he will follow God. In Exodus, God powerfully keeps faith (Person) by using Moses to lead the family of Abraham (People) out of slavery into the Wilderness wanderings, where he cares for (Provision) and shapes his people. In Joshua, God keeps his promise (Provision) to give Abraham’s descendants (People) a land in which to live, thus proving himself (Person) to be the faithful provider.

Today we read of Abraham’s descendants (People) breaking faith through idolatrous disobedience repeatedly in the stories in the time of the Judges. The stories told in this book are violent and sordid, because the people of God are turning away, wandering off into the idolatrous practices of their neighbors. God proves himself to be faithful (Person) to his people by raising up judges (Provision), rulers who give them periods of peace while Israel returns to God.

In the various stories you might read here, you will be shocked by the violence and the seediness of the people who are called to follow God. God can use anyone, from any background, if they will rely on him. Many times we may feel disconnected from the day-to-day events in lives of the Bible stories. These stories are even more uncomfortable to our ears. But see the “big picture”, these people get caught up in day-to-day survival. They feel they must do all kinds of things to compromise. Eventually compromise becomes routine, then life becomes unbearable. Prayer becomes the answer, and they (People) cry out for help from God. God faithfully (Person) responds with a “judge” (Provision) and a period of reprieve. They forget, and the cycle repeats, like us.

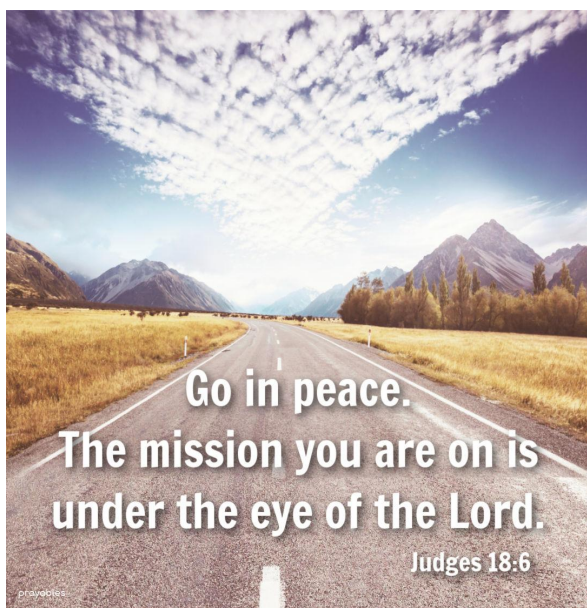
