We've walked through the Bible together and looked at what God says about himself, his people and the assistance he offers to his people. We've seen stories where God is contrasted with the idols and false gods throughout history; Baals, Asherah, and Dagon are names you might remember. We have seen God lead Israel into battle. We've read the stories of captivities, periods of bondage within Egypt, and Babylon. We've looked, listened, and read... so what?

We hope your answer is, "Wow, God is remarkably consistent." We hope you noticed how faithful he has been, even after his people have stumbled and fumbled their way along. We want you to see these stories so you can project into your own future about how God will deal with you.

Faith is a process of moving the facts of God's history into our own future, depending on it. If God can love Deborah, he can love you. If God can use Samson, he can use us. The question is, "What will that look like?"

Hannah and Elkanah were childless. She prayed fervently that she might conceive. The story is not there to tell us that God always grants a child to a barren couple. The story is telling us that when God granted them a son, Samuel, that they were faithful in following God in using that child to become a great Prophet and Judge. She sacrificed rearing her son, to be obedient before God. Life does not follow a predefined script, but God was present for both Hannah and Elkanah when the story did not go as they had planned. When the script of your plan changes, how do you do? Can you still follow God, walk humbly before him when life is thrown into chaos? It is your story now.
