As they were building their support base, they reached out to our church because of the Godfreys. We have supported them for nearly 30 years as they have faithfully served the Lord in that city, raising their children, Aaron and Emily, now recently married, and their 9-yr old Violet.

We've seen their compassion for the marginalized of society which has brought them into a new work helping the overwhelming numbers of migrants crossing into southern Mexico from Central and South America. As a preacher, Coco brings hope by sharing the Good news of Jesus. As a midwife, Tish provides health care to the women and children. As part of our worship service today, we will hear from the Serrano family about the work they are currently doing in Oaxaca City.
