Prayer is basic. Prayer provides the primary language for everything that takes place on the way of Jesus. If we go to a shopping mall in North America, we speak English to get what we want. If we go to a restaurant in France, we speak French to order. If we travel in Greece, we speak Greek to find our way to the Acropolis. And if we decide to become Christians and follow Jesus, we pray. We pray because it is the only language we have for speaking to the God revealed in Jesus. It is also the only language we have for listening to the commands and blessings and guidance that God provides through Jesus. God is nothing if not personal. Both God and we humans are most personal, most characteristically our unique selves, in our use of language. When language has to do with God and us, us and God, we call it prayer.

What I want to insist on is that prayer is not something added on to the Christian life. It is the language in which that life is lived out, nurtured, developed, revealed, informed; the language in which it believes, loves, explores, seeks, and finds. There are no shortcuts or detours. Prayer is the cradle language among those who are "born again" and then the intimate, familiar, developing language of growing up to follow the way of Jesus.

Prayer is the street language that we use with Jesus, who walks the streets with us. We can't put off prayer until we "get good at it." It is the only language available to us as we bring our unique and particular selves, "just as we are without one plea," into the daily, hourly speaking and listening to God who comes "just as he is" in Jesus.
