In the last two sermon series we have walked through the major stories of the Bible in varying degrees of detail. We have witnessed the faithfulness of a loving God who patiently has guided his people. We have seen the consistency with which he disciplined both individuals, like Moses, Saul, and David, as well as the nation of Israel collectively during the wilderness wanderings, the entrance into the promised land, and their demand for a king. Clearly God has both expectations for us, disciplines to draw us back to him, along with blessings as we walk in humility before him.

On our two trips through the Scriptures we have seen the consistent love that God expresses for his people. I want to challenge you to think of an area in your life that you want to improve to God's glory. He has invited you to walk with him; perhaps you could commit to do one of the following?

A. Have a more consistent prayer life. Our digital devices can be helpful here. Have Alexa, Siri, or Google remind you at a specific time each day to stop for a few minutes of prayer.

B. Begin a reflection journal. One productive discipline for disciples is to take 5 minutes at the end of the day to reflect on the blessings of God during the day. Write in a journal each night about the areas of your life that you are grateful to experience. Just 5 minutes to reflect on God's gracious provision.

- C. Be an intentional blessing to others. Target one person each week to pray for, bless or connect with.
- D. Be increasingly present with other disciples. Both at worship times and socially.

You can choose, but make an effort to apply what you have learned in our studies together.
