We all get hurt and offended throughout our lives. But we have a choice: to hold on to the offense or choose to forgive. Forgiveness doesn't erase the hurt that was caused; it's a choice to break free from its grip and not let it run your life! Life is all about relationships with people and they will require a lot of work (Family, friendships, romance, workplace, community, etc.). Because people are complicated, relationships will experience complicated moments. Forgiveness is one of the most courageous acts a person can choose.

Luke 6:27-28: "But to you who are willing to listen, I say, love your enemies! Do good to those who hate you. Bless those who curse you. Pray for those who hurt you." Forgiveness is the act of releasing someone from the debt of their offense, not because they deserve it, but because you have been forgiven by God.

Matthew 6:12: "And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors." Forgiveness does not condone their actions. Forgiveness does not require reconciliation. Emotions can make forgiveness challenging because of the message they communicate.

Colossians 3:13: "Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others." C.S. Lewis said - "To be a Christian means to forgive the inexcusable because God has forgiven the inexcusable in you." Forgiveness will require a willingness to surrender that God can take care of my hurt better than I can. Godly people forgive others.
