



What is your life? This is a very important question for Christians. Our life is what occupies our time, energy, and thoughts. So, what occupies your time, energy, and thoughts? If you were to write down everything that you do for a week – how much of your time would be doing things that are godly? How much of your time would be doing things that would help develop you into a better disciple of Jesus? How much of your time would be spent on things that ultimately are of very little or no value in the Kingdom of God?

An experiment that has been used to help people find out how much time they spend on particular apps is simply to take out your phone and search for what apps you use most when your screen is turned on. Often times when people look at this data (this is not data that most people want to look at because it might shock them) it shows that they spend a lot of time on their phones and other devices doing things that would not help them in their discipleship with Jesus – in fact, many of these things are just frivolous and have little to no value at all. This is a good way to see how we spend some of our time, but we may need to do more.

Sit down and write out everything you do for a week – where do you spend the bulk of your time? Now take your job out of the equation and look at the hours that you are awake and not working at your job – what are you doing? Examine what kinds of things you do with your time – and then ask – do these things help me be a better disciple? Then act accordingly.
